Guidelines and Deadlines:

1. Submission of Piece: a written or digital copy of your finished piece(s) must be submitted with your Statements application by Aug. 3. Please submit in pdf., .txt, or .doc document only, and .doc or .txt is preferred. If you are submitting several things, please make sure they are separate and labeled with the title and your name or group name. Turn in completed application, along with a digital file or CD of your piece, to Laura Pearson at The Refuge on a Sunday evening or mail to P.O. Box 6805, Broomfield 80021. You may also e-mail your submission to wordinart@therefugeonline.org. Submissions must be edited and ready for print. The Statements coordinator will not be proofreading or editing for content in any way. All Statements submissions will be printed and bound with other submissions for visitors to read. If you need assistance with your application please contact the Statements events coordinator, Joel Hughes at wordinart@therefugeonline.org.

2. Acceptance of Pieces: Unless you receive a call from an events coordinator, your pieces are automatically accepted.

3. Spoken Word: If you would like to read your submission, please fill out a stage application as well.

Visitors, family and friends may have questions about your creative work and we will be handing out a few special prizes for entries in several categories.
